

- Safety By Commitment -

It is something I believe every Rider should care about. I know that when I go for a ride with people I don't know real well, i.e. visiting a Chapter and going for ice cream afterwards, I look to see who is in Rider Education at, at least, Level I, and try to fall in line next to them. I like knowing that this Rider is committed to safety. It bothers me to have a Rider ahead or behind me who, suddenly at 60 miles an hour, raises both hands above his head for several seconds! Sorry, I don't like to think of what could happen in those few split seconds, to them, OR, to me! Think of your Co-Rider. I know you care for them, as they care for you. Be concerned about their safety. I know you aren't going to ride at 70 MPH on icy roads. I know you aren't going to close your eyes and see how long you ride in a straight line. So, let everyone you ride with know that! Become a Level I Rider and Co-Rider. Let them know that, yes by golly, you do care about your safety as well as theirs. Once you are a Level I, you never have to "renew" to remain at that level.

So, as you think of New Year Resolutions, think of Safety By Commitment, for you and for your Co-Rider. I think the inner knowledge and self-satisfaction you get for letting people know you are committed to safety is well worth the effort.


Tis the Season for Mall Shows!


