Georgia's All-Chapter Challenge Wing Fling 2010

Georgia Invites All GWRRA Chapters, from every District, to participate in it's Exciting HIAWASSEE DOWNS Gold Wing Race! Scheduled to take place in Hiawassee, Georgia at the Georgia 2010 'American Gold Wing Bandstand' District Rally. And don't forget to take that Wing Visiting to be eligible for the Most Visited and Most Traveled Wing Awards!

Racing Wing Specifications

Each Chapter creates a Wooden Gold Wing as follows:

- Base: 12" Round with smaller round piece above for stability
- Pole: 1/2" Dowel approximately 28" tall
- Gold Wing: Cut from Template – recommended 1" wood
- Decoration: Chapters Prerogative – Should reflect personality of chapter
- Designation: Recommended that somewhere on Wing the Chapter Name, Letter Designation, District & Region are shown
- Visitation: Some indication of chapters visited whether it be visitation
Rocker Pins or homemade pins/rockers, etc.

The above specifications are recommendations and are not required or exact – keep dimensions as close as possible to above criteria, but variances will be accepted.



Track Specifications

Track will be approximately 30' long x 12' wide and shall have 8 lanes consisting of 14" x 14" squares

The track length will be 25 squares. Placed at random on the track shall be penalty & bonus squares:

| “Wing on Right Goes Back 3 Spaces” | “Wing on Left Goes Back 3 Spaces” |
| “Take the Lead – one Square ahead of leading bike” | “Drop to Last – one Square behind trailing bike” |

The Race

Chapters will draw for the first heat – eight per race. Eight dice will be rolled, one per chapter – the chapter wings will move accordingly. If Racing Wing lands on bonus or penalty square, it must move accordingly. Each group of eight Racing Wings will run two heats, with the winners going to the Winner's Circle. If number of Chapters participating is too large, the number of heats may be reduced to one per group. After all heats, winning chapters will run a special heat for Win, Place & Show Cash Prizes:

Win: \$75.00 * Place: \$50.00 * Show: \$25.00

Special Prizes for other Heat Winners!

ROAD CAPTAIN PRIZE for Best Tail Gunner! (Drawn from tail gunners from all heats)

Most Visited and Most Traveled Wing Awards

Chapters will take their Racing Wings traveling to visit chapters or events (bars optional) anywhere across the world! A Chapter, District or Region Officer must sign the Visitation Log including date & mileage to verify visit. Chapter must have a minimum of four members and can be on 2, 3 or 4 wheels. Blank Visitation Logs can be downloaded from the Georgia District Website at www.gwr-ra-ga.com. TWO FREE GEORGIA 2011 RALLY REGISTRATIONS and a commemorative plaque will be given to the Chapter with the most chapter or event visitations. Special plaques will be awarded for the highest total mileage and for the single longest distance taken to visit another chapter or event. Mileage is one way and **not** multiplied by number of chapter members.
