The Horizon class sessions will start promptly at 8:00 AM on Saturday morning, and conclude no later than 2:00 PM on Sunday. **Participants must be able to attend all sessions (both days) to receive credit for program attendance.** At the completion of the program, each participant will receive the Leadership Training Pin, Horizon Hanger Bar, and Certificate of Completion. There is a \$10.00 per person charge to attend Horizon to defray cost of the facility and refreshments. These training expenses are legitimate Chapter expenses with approval of Chapter Director.

Other Classes and Programs

(Chapter Leadership Skills, Intermediate Leadership Skills, Advanced Leadership Skills)

The Chapter Skills Program is open to anyone wishing to attend. This is a follow-on to the Horizon Program. The Horizon Program teaches the “Why” of what goes on in a GWRRA Chapter; the Chapter Skills Program teaches the “How” to make those things happen. A hanger bar and certificate of completion is provided at the completion of this program which consists of eight seminars, all of which can be provided in a one-day session.

Intermediate Leadership Skills Program is available to all members who have completed both the Horizon and Chapter Skills Programs. All CDs and ACDs are strongly encouraged to complete the Intermediate Leadership Skills Program. The program consists of seminars focused primarily on Assistant Chapter Directors, or any member for that matter, who will be stepping up to the position of Chapter Director. A hanger bar and certificate of completion will be provided to those members completing this program.

Advanced Leadership Skills Program is the fourth and final in the leadership skills programs. This program is intended for those CDs and ACDs after they have been in those positions for at least 6 months, and have attended the Horizon, Chapter Skills, and Intermediate Skills Programs. A hanger bar and certificate of completion will be provided to those members completing this program.

Officer Certification Program The Officer Certification Program is a 1½ day Program for all Directors and Assistant Directors at all levels of GWRRA (Region, District, and Chapter). Classes will begin at 8:30 am on Saturday and Sunday. The Saturday session will end between 5:30 and 6:00 pm. The Sunday session will end around 1:00 pm. The OCP is open to all members of GWRRA, regardless of position, but is required for all officers as stated above.
